Policies & Lesson Agreement

Tuition:

Tuition for a regular weekly 30 minute lesson in person or online is \$145 for a set of four lessons. For students taking more than one weekly lesson or families with more than one student taking lessons Musicology offers a Family Plan. Every additional set of four lessons in person or online is \$135 for four regular weekly 30 minute lessons. The set of four lessons must be taken in succession. If you cannot make your lessons consistently, we do offer spot lessons for \$45 per lesson that might be a better fit for you.

Lessons will not be given without payment in advance. Tuition for the next four classes is due on the third paid lesson. If Musicology has not received tuition by the last paid lesson, your time-slot will be made available to other clients that are seeking appointments. Responsibility pertaining to when tuition is due falls solely upon the student/parent. All tuition payments must be paid in full by either cash, check, or credit card. Please note that checks must be made payable to Musicology. Tuition is completely non-refundable. The student/parent may terminate lessons at any time without notice; however, no refunds will be given in any form. Bounced checks will be subject to a thirty-five dollar charge.

Make-Ups & Rescheduling:

Due to the fact that the time you agreed to take is solely yours, no make-ups or reschedules will be given for any missed lessons. In the event that you cannot make the lesson in person you can take the lesson online. If a make-up lesson or rescheduled lesson is offered, it is at the discretion and convenience of the Instructor. Due to limited time-slots and availabilities, missed lessons will not be credited or refunded in any form. However, exceptions can be made under certain circumstances, but only at the discretion of Musicology. Same day cancellations cannot be made up or rescheduled.

If the Instructor is unavailable to make the lesson either in person or online for any reason, and we cannot provide a Substitute Instructor, you will not be charged. Advance notice will be given for Instructor absences whenever possible.

In the event a scheduled lesson falls on the following major holidays Easter, July 4th, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas, New Year's Eve, or New Year's Day, you will not be charged in any way. Musicology is closed on the following major holidays: Easter Weekend (Friday-Sunday), Memorial Day Weekend (Friday-Monday), Fourth of July, Labor Day

Instruments, Materials, & What to Bring to Lessons:

The Instructors at Musicology all attempt to make learning music as fun as possible, and an instrument is not always necessary to begin lessons. It is best if students taking guitar lessons have a guitar and bring it with them to their lessons, but if they are just wanting to try it out, Musicology has a guitar available for students to borrow during the lesson. Piano and Drum students only need to bring their sticks or papers, and whatever else might be relevant to their lesson. All students should bring the music assigned to them by their instructor each week. At Musicology we understand that purchasing an instrument can be a big decision, please understand, however, that the longer that you wait to purchase an instrument, the more likely a student will be to get bored and quit.

Tuition Increases and Policy Changes:

Musicology reserves the right to increase tuition rates at any time. Written notice will always be given prior to an increase. However, Musicology reserves the right to change any policies set forth in this document at any time without prior written notification to anyone. Increases in tuition will not affect lessons that have already been paid for; the tuition increase will apply starting with the next payment of tuition due.
